Intergenerational initiatives Contest 2024 QUEBEC INTERGENERATIONAL WEEK

I. PARTICIPATION CONDITIONS

The contest rewards activities or projects that promote intergenerational connections.

To be eligible for the contest, an initiative must meet the following prerequisites :

1. The project must be organized by a non-profit organization or an individual*.
2. The project must directly involve at least two generations, not from the same family.
3. The project must take place between April 2023 and February 2024, on a one-time, occasional or regular basis.
4. A project cannot compete if it has been awarded in the two years preceding this edition of the contest. However former winners may, submit a different project.
5. Political or proselytizing organizations or those that discriminate on grounds of age, origin, sex or religion will be excluded.

***NEW HONORIFIC CATEGORY:** Municipalities and private companies can submit a project in this category. The winner of this category will receive a distinction but will not receive a bursary.

Intergénération Québec reserves the right to not select a project if the submitted application does not meet these criteria or lack of clarity.

II. EVALUATION CRITERIA

To determine the finalists and winners, the contest selection committee will select projects that :

- A. Promote mutually beneficial social connections for each of the generations involved (notion of reciprocity).
- B. Contribute to individual quality of life (break isolation, encourage learning, improve sense of usefulness or physical and mental health).
- C. Generate collective social effects (combating ageism, encouraging social participation, fostering inclusion or a sense of belonging).
- D. Evaluate their qualitative and quantitative impact.

Initiatives that involve the most vulnerable or marginalized people will be favored.

Why register ?

- to gain visibility by appearing in [Réso't'âges](#), our dynamic and interactive list of intergenerational projects, and thus inspire other organizations,
- for a chance to win an award at a forum that brings together Quebec's intergenerational solidarity actors and to win a **1000 \$ bursary**.



How to register ?



Fill out the [online registration](#) form directly on our website. Thank you for detailing your activity and answering all questions.

Additional information may be required to confirm your registration.

Only one attachment is allowed (poster, complementary document, picture, etc.).

Once your form is sent, make sure you receive an acknowledgment from us.

To be declared finalists, participants will have to:

- **respond** to Intergénération Québec's phone calls within 10 working days following the selection,
- **provide**, within the prescribed time, at least one printable resolution photo illustrating their initiative.

The bursary must be accepted and forwarded **within three months** after the award ceremony and may, in no case, be in whole or in part transferred or exchanged.

The decisions of the selection committee are final and without appeal.

When to register ?

From Monday, November 13, 2023 to Sunday, February 25, 2024 at the latest.
